MOBILE PHONE POLICY

Mobile phones have become a part of today's lifestyle and almost all students possess them. However, in order to ensure the safety and security and zero disruption to the learning environment **students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school. Only in case of emergency situations,** if parents feel the need to permit their children to bring mobile phones to school, the following rules apply:

- 1. An email must be sent by the parents to the relevant Year Leader and/or Form Tutor with clearly stated reason for sending mobile phone to school.
- 2. The student must give it to the Year Leader in the morning and collect it at the dispersal time only.
- 3. The school accepts no responsibility for mobile phones and undertakes no responsibility to investigate misplacement, loss or theft.
- 4. Under no circumstances should a student be found using the phone in the school campus. If a phone rings, or is seen by a member of staff, or if inappropriate use is made of the phone, it will be confiscated, and action will be taken as per the sanctions below.
- 5. If a student is found misusing mobile phone on the school bus or in the own transport waiting area, it will immediately be confiscated by the present staff member.

Sanctions:

- If a student is found using the mobile phone during school hours by a member of staff, the member of staff will confiscate it immediately. The member of staff will bring it to the HOS/YLS where it will be stored in a locked safe place. They will clearly state in the logbook the name of the student the phone has been taken from and the circumstances which led to the confiscation.
- On the first occasion on which the student's phone is confiscated within a year, they will
 be able to collect it from the office of the Head of School or Year Leader at the end of
 the day.
- On the second occasion within a year on which their phone is confiscated, their parent/guardian will be contacted and asked to collect the phone in person.
- On the third occasion within a term the phone will be confiscated, parents informed, and the phone returned to the student at the end of term in the presence of the parent.
- Any student who refuses to hand over a mobile phone when requested to do so by staff will be reported to the HOS/YL and the refusal will be liable to disciplinary action.
