Uniform and Appearance Guidelines

All students are required to wear their full school uniform daily. This includes black school shoes, which are mandatory for all students. Hooded jackets are not allowed. Students must wear their PE uniforms on the days allocated in their timetables. Respecting the school's appearance guidelines is essential. Students are not permitted to wear makeup, have nail polish, or display unconventional hairstyles. We believe that maintaining a clean and traditional appearance fosters discipline and helps students focus on their education.

Teachers will conduct daily checks to ensure that all students adhere to the school uniform and appearance guidelines. We trust that our students will take pride in their appearance and represent Arab Unity School as responsible and respectful individuals. International Benchmark Assessments- Term 1
